Terms and Conditions

1. Each entrant will be allocated a unique ticket number for each ticket purchased.
2. Competition is open to anyone over the age of 18 years, excluding full-time staff of the CSO.
3. Once purchased, raffle tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
4. By purchasing a raffle ticket, entrants acknowledge that they have read and accepted these terms and conditions.
5. The raffle draw will be conducted under the supervision of the CSO's independent auditors. The outcome of the draw shall be final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the result.
6. Tickets will be on sale until 27th August 2026, when the draw takes place. All entries must be received by this date.
7. The draw will take place on 27th August 2026 in Sandton, Johannesburg.
8. Attendance at the draw is not required. All valid entries received by the closing date will automatically be entered into the draw, and winners will be eligible to win regardless of whether they are present at the draw.
9. The prize winners will be notified by means of a telephone call and/or email by using the contact details the entrants provided. Should the incorrect details be provided and you cannot be contacted a new winner will be drawn.
10. The winner will be required to provide a valid South African identity document or passport and any other documentation reasonably required to verify eligibility and facilitate transfer of the prize.
11. The prize is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash or any other alternative.
